Dear Parents

I hope you and your families are safe and well.

You will know that schools have been able to arrange for groups of students to return to school for short periods of time over the last couple of weeks. The government gave schools strict rules to abide by for these partial re-openings and instructed us to focus on year 10 and 12 students with these plans.

Further guidance has now been issued and so I am beginning to make plans for sessions to be held in the week beginning 13<sup>th</sup> July for year 9 students and their parents.

We are obviously very limited by the restrictions which have been placed on us but I want to invite year 9 students and parents in, in groups, for what in effect will be an extended parents evening – but during the day! These sessions will enable you to receive a summary of your son's progress this year, along with his targets and action for the future, that would in normal circumstances have been in his written report.

Before I confirm the plans, I want to ask if you would be able to attend one of these sessions. I envisage us arranging 4 sessions for year 9 across Monday and Tuesday, 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> July. Please click on the link below to complete the questionnaire.
